### Welcome

### Congress programme

The Congress programme will be published on the ISCA and Congress websites prior to the Congress. On most afternoons there are a variety of activities and/or excursion options, places for these will be allocated on the first day of the Congress according to interest levels. There will be a full day excursion on Wednesday November 5<sup>th</sup> to visit the highlights of the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area.

### Papers guide

An initial call for papers was issued in December 2013. Please submit abstracts to the panel by the advised cut off date of 30<sup>th</sup> June. All papers will be 20 minutes with 5 minutes for questions.

With a limit of 25 paper slots, the Congress organisers do reserve the right to decline papers. We will try to advise speakers as soon as possible.

### Pre- and post- Congress trips

There are two planned official Congress trips. A pre-congress trip will be based in Sydney, and offer a hosted tour of the major attractions of the city with the advantage of local knowledge. The post-Congress trip will travel from Jenolan Caves to the city of Melbourne via the major Australian east-coast show caves of Wombeyan, Yarrongobilly and Buchan. Expected costs are given in the registration form. The price for the post Congress trip includes transport, accommodation, meals and accompanying hosts. The organisers will try to provide flexibility in eating and accommodation options for the group. Those indicating interest in these programmes will be contacted with further details.

We will contact those registering for the 'partners programme' and discuss the local options before finalising this itinerary.

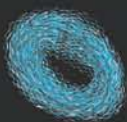
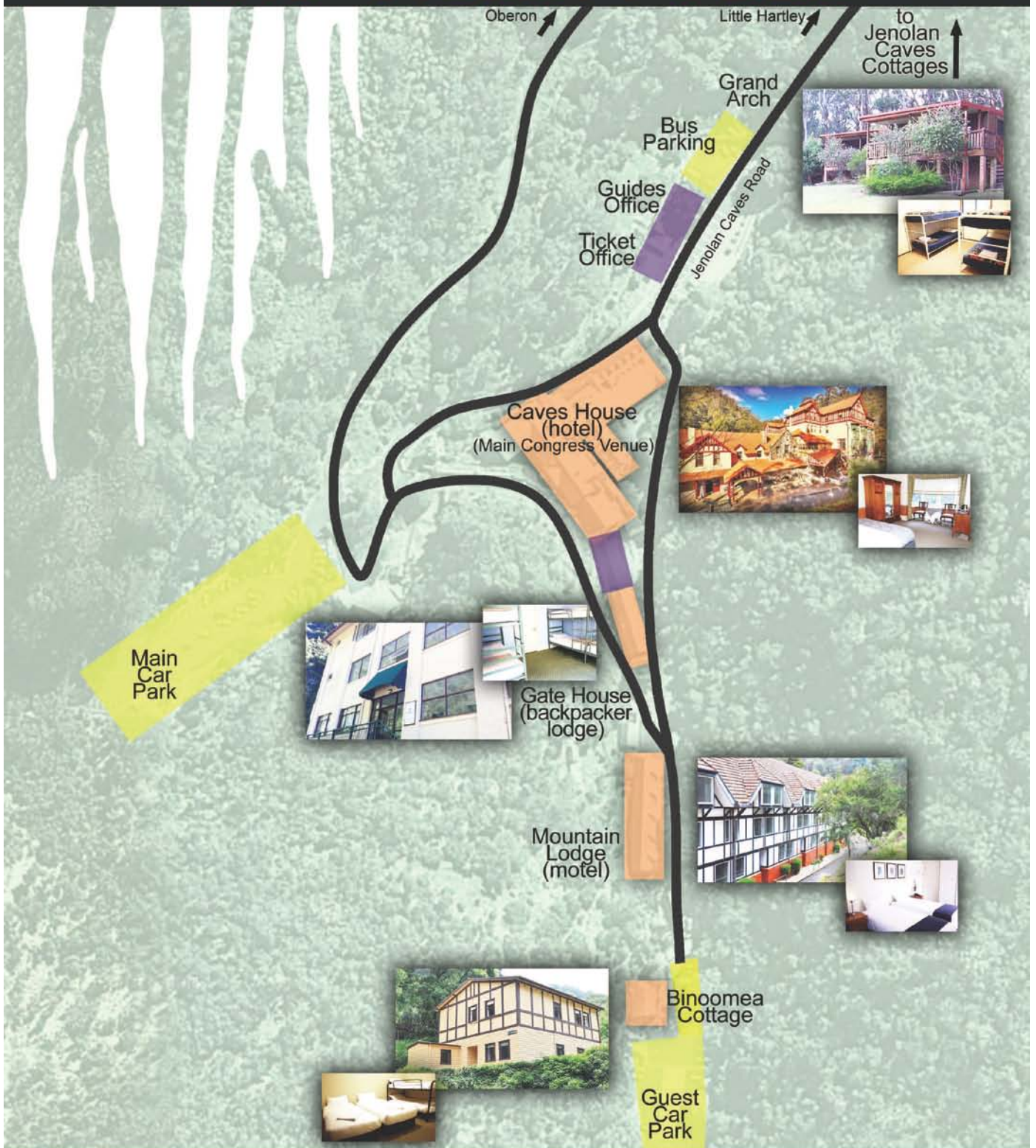
## Accommodation Guide

1. All prices are per night in AUD(\$) and include Goods and Services Tax (GST)
2. All accommodation listed is located at Jenolan Caves within close walking distance of the Congress Venue except the *Jenolan Caves Cottages* 8km distant. A shuttle bus will provide transport to and from these cottages to the Congress venue daily.
